OCCUPY AND OBSTRUCT STREET

A permit was granted to the Grace Congregational Church to occupy and obstruct Pearl Street, from Union Ave. to Sanger St., for the purpose of conducting a street fair, from 7 P.M. on September 8 to midnight on September 10.

HEARING

A public hearing was held at 2 P.M., in the Selectmen's Office, Room 21, Memorial Building, on the petition of the Boston Edison Co. for permission to construct, and a location for, a line of twenty-four wires, of which three wires are to be under and twenty-one wires are to be aboveground, the said wires to be located within a strip 250 feet wide, on Old Conn. Path, at Danforth Street. No one was present in favor of, or in opposition to, the granting of this petition and the same was granted.


