HEARINGS

A public hearing, continued from November 15, was held at 2:13 P.M., in the Selectmen's Office, Room 21, Memorial Building, on the petition of the Modern Building Corp. and others to lay out Londonderry Road, approximately 225' from Wesley Road to Londonderry Road approximately 225' as and for a public way. Harold Drugan appeared in favor, and no one was present in opposition to it. The matter was taken under advisement.

A public hearing was held at 2:13 P.M., in the Selectmen's Office, Room 21, Memorial Building, on the petition of the Modern Building Corp. and others to lay out North Lane, approximately 240' from Wesley Road to corner of Londonderry Road, as and for a public way. Harold Drugan appeared in favor and no one was present in opposition to it. The matter was taken under advisement.

A public hearing was held at 2:50 P.M., in the Selectmen's Office, Room 21, Memorial Building, on the petition of the Framingham Housing Authority to lay out G St., from Corregidor Rd. to the extension of Guadalcanal Rd., and to lay out Guadalcanal Rd. extension from Arsenal Rd. westerly, approximately 500' as and for public ways. Robert J. Bliss, Framingham Housing Authority Director, appeared in favor. No one was present in opposition to it, and the Board voted to recommend acceptance of these streets by the town.


