REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN JANUARY 30, 1956

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PETITION

CONFERENCES

Fire Chief Leroy Trevett discussed with the Board, at 2:10 o'clock P.M., Privates Carr and Ahearn who are both out on sick leave. The Chief was instructed to investigate the possibilities of both privates requesting retirement allowance under the Contributory Retirement System. The Chief requested that an article be placed in the warrant for the town meeting for retirement allowances for Mrs. Julia Ryan, Mrs. Antoinette Ryan, Mrs. Helen J. Cooney, Mrs. Sarah Graham and Mrs. Winifred Ellsworth under the provisions of Chapter 32, Sections 95, 96, 97.

Donald Johnson and Walter Riley conferred with the Board at 2:30 o'clock P.M. requesting acceptance of Gregory Road, Hadley Road, Burbank Circle, Oakvale Road, Davidson Road, Whittemore Road, in the Oakvale section of Framingham. They were instructed to file formal petitions with the Selectmen's Office this week. They also requested that a special police officer be appointed in this area, and agreed to submit a name at a later date.

HEARING

A hearing was held at 3 o'clock P.M., on complaint of the Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission that the La Cantina Club, Inc., Leo J. Mencoboni, Mgr., 911 Waverly Street, Framingham, did violate Chapter 138, Section 34 of the General Laws, by selling alcoholic beverages to persons under twenty-one years of age. Thomas B. Ford, Investigator for the Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission, stated that on Friday, January 6, 1956 at 10:20 P.M., he found two patrons, Eugene Nardini, Jr., born October 9, 1935 drinking Ruperts beer, and Frances Ann Simpson, born June 28, 1935 drinking a Rye highball on the premises of the La Cantina Club, Inc. The waitress, Mrs. Lee Reinhadt, admitted making the sale without questioning the ages of the patrons. J. Walton Tuttle, counsel for Mr. Mencoboni, stated that the waitress assumed they were over twenty-one years of age because of their size. While it is admitted that this is not a legal excuse for violating the law, there was no intention of violating any law and this is the first violation. Mr. Hartnett stated that this Board does not condone any violations of Chapter 138 and that waitresses should be more careful in order to secure orderly control of the sale and service of alcoholic beverages. He also asked the Manager, Mr. Mencoboni,

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if he had taken any action since the reported violation. Mr. Mencoboni stated that since that day his waitresses were instructed to make no sales to any one who looks under age regardless of any proof they might offer. Mr. Tuttle stated that there would be no further violation. Mr. Hartnett informed Mr. Mencoboni that the Board will investigate, personally, from time to time. The matter was taken under advisement, and all parties will be notified of the decision.

RECESS - CONFERENCE

The Board recessed from 3:30 to 5 P.M., at which time they met with the following members of the Personnel Board: Messrs. Shapiro, Taft, Purcell and Silva. Attorney Shapiro stated that there would be a general salary increase of \$150.00 for all female employees and \$250.00 for all male employees, plus an additional increase which has not been publicized as yet which would amount to \$75.00 after ten years of service and another \$75.00 after twenty years of service, and which would apply only to the girls. He further stated that there had been no major change over a period of years and that the Personnel Board felt that the general increase would bring all personnel into line comparable with other towns. Increases for department heads were discussed and compared with the salary of Public Works Director and the Medical Health Officer, and the Personnel Board was requested to reconsider their action in regard to the increases for department heads. They agreed to do so at the next meeting which would be on January 31, 1956 and to inform this Board of their decision.


