HEARINGS

A public hearing was held at 2:30 P.M. in the Selectmen's Office, Room 21, Memorial Building, on the petition of the Boston Edison Co. JO New Eng. Tel. & Tel. Co. for one pole on Grove St., westerly side approximately 25' south of Edmands Rd., three poles on Grove St., easterly side, southerly from a point approximately 90' south of Edmands Rd., one pole on Grove St., westerly side approximately 415' south of Edmands Rd. No one was present in favor of, or in opposition to, the granting of this petition and the same was granted.
