The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen was held at 7:30 P.M.

HEARING

A public hearing was held at 8:45 P.M. in the Selectmen's Office,
Room 21, Memorial Building, on the application of Ralph W. Turner for a
license to use the land at 284 Hollis St. (formerly listed as 280-282 Hollis
St., Framingham) for the storage of 6,000 gallons, additional, gasoline
in two-3,000 gallon tanks underground.

Thomas Cronin represented Texaco Inc. and Roy Dias appeared. Mr. Dias
presented return receipts indicating abutters had been notified. There
were no objectors, and the license was granted.
