July 3, 1960 to June 25, 1961.


PETITIONS

The petition of the Western Union Telegraph Company, New Eng. Tel. & Tel. Co. and Boston Edison Co. for the transfer of one pole located on Columbia St., southeasterly side at South St. (this is an existing pole - no new poles to be set) - to the Boston Edison Co. JO New Eng. Tel. & Tel. Co., was granted.
