Co. for the following permission: Concord St. and Cochituate Rd., from manhole 241 on Concord St. to and extending along Cochituate Rd. to pole 39, approximately 2080' of conduit and 3 manholes; Cochituate Rd., from manhole 252, approximately 2042' northeast of Concord St., crossing Cochituate Road, to property line, approximately 45' of conduit. LEAVE OF ABSENCE


It was voted to grant the request of Police Patrolman Peter Pleshaw for a leave of absence for a period of four months from September 13, 1964 to enable him to further his education.
