Co. for the following permission: Speen St., from existing conduit, approximately 214' northwest of Cochituate Rd., extending along Speen St. to property line. There were no objection, and the petition was granted.

A public hearing was held at 8 P.M. in the Selectmen's Office, Room 21, Memorial Building, on the petition of the New Eng. Tel. & Tel. Co. for the following permission: Old Worcester Road, from pole 125/8, approximately 1098' westerly from Temple St., to property line, approximately 6' of conduit. There were no objections, and the petition was granted.

\*PETITIONS\*

The petition of the Boston Edison Co. JO New Eng. Tel. & Tel. Co. for one pole (one existing JO pole to be removed) on Salem End Road, northwesterly side, approximately 332' southwest of Temple St., was granted.

The petition of the New Eng. Tel. & Tel. Co. for the following permission was granted.


Concord St., from manhole 229 at Dennison Ave., extending along Concord St. to manhole 235, approximately 3603' of conduit, 4 manholes and 2 manhole enlargements, Concord St., from manhole 230, approximately 621' north of Dennison Avenue, to pole 33, approximately 36' of conduit, Concord St., from manhole 231, approximately 1249' north of Dennison Ave. to pole 39, approximately 66' of conduit, Concord St. and Anzio Rd., from manhole 235, approximately 36' north of Anzio Road, to and extending along Anzio Road to pole 436/1, approximately 116' of conduit. (This cancels and supercedes petition and order adopted May 7, 1956, recorded in Town Clerk's book 9, page 681, because work was never done).

\*SIGNS\*

It was voted to authorize the Police Department to place a "Not a Through Way" sign at the intersection of Prior Drive and Carling Road, and a "Go Slow Children" sign on Clearview Drive at Belknap Road.
