\*HEARINGS\*

A public hearing was held at 8 P.M. in the Selectmen's Office, Room 21, Memorial Building, on the application of John Fiore for a license to use the land at 206-214 Howard St. for the storage of 6800 gallons of fuel oil, in one underground tank, for private use.

John Fiore presented return receipts indicating abutters had been notified.

There was no objection to the granting of the license, and the license was granted.

A public hearing was held at 8 P.M. in the Selectmen's Office, Room 21, Memorial Building, on the petition of the Boston Edison Co. JO New Eng. Tel. & Tel. Co. for the following permission: Frost St., southwesterly side, southeasterly from a point approximately 75' southeast of Edgell Road, two poles (three existing JO poles to be removed), Frost St., northeasterly side, southeasterly from a point approximately 555' southeast of Edgell Road, three poles (three existing JO poles to be removed), Frost St., northeasterly side, approximately 148' southeast of Terri Rd., one pole (one existing JO pole to be removed). There was no objection to the granting of this petition, and the same was granted.

A public hearing was held at 8 P.M. in the Selectmen's Office, Room 21, Memorial Building, on the petition of the New Eng. Tel. & Tel. Co. for the following permission: Water St., from pole 224/57, opposite Riner St., crossing Water St. to manhole 655, approximately 62' of buried cable. There was no objection to the granting of this petition, and the same was granted.

All members of the Planning Board conferred with the Board of Selectmen at 8:30 P.M. regarding a variance granted by the Zoning Board of Appeals to David A. & Joseph S. Brossi.

The Planning Board indicated that they may ask for special counsel to contest this variance.

\*BUILDING INSPECTOR\*


