SELECTMEN'S RECORDS

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN - JUNE 22, 1976

A Special Meeting of the Board of Selectmen was held at 7:00 P.M. Present: Mr. Peter W. Ablondi, Chairman, Mr. John F. DelPrete, Clerk and Mr. John F. King.

The meeting was called to order at 7:20 P.M. by Chairman Ablondi for the purpose of taking specific action and recorded votes on the position of the Selectmen on Articles to be considered in the Special Town Meeting of this date. After consideration of Article #1, Selectman King moved that the Board of Selectmen support the article to take the permanent and temporary easements for the Saxonville Flood Control Project as outlined in the article by eminent domain. It was further moved that an amount of \$54,370 be requested for the purposes of these takings. It was pointed out that this was the only official appraisal available and, therefore, the only basis on which a firm figure could be established. Selectman DelPrete seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Article #2 concerning the appropriation of additional funds for the purpose of renting the parking lot area which is owned by the Shaughnessy Estate was discussed. It was determined that the \$6600 already appropriated in the Annual Town Meeting was sufficient to give a base for further negotiation to arrive at an acceptable price. Selectman DelPrete moved that the same rental rate of \$6600. be accepted. Selectman King moved that the article be referred back to the sponsor. After a discussion which resulted in the conclusion that the motion to refer back to the sponsor gave greater flexibility to the Selectmen and the Town Counsel for the purposes of negotiation, Selectman DelPrete withdrew his original motion and a unanimous vote adopted the motion for reference to the sponsor.

It was agreed that the vote taken to recommend that a pay increase of 5% for all employees, including those who have not yet signed their labor agreements, be included in this warrant was sufficient to establish a unanimous agreement.
