A REQUEST FOR SPECIAL TOWN MEETING WARRANT ARTICLES - R. M. BRADLEY & COMPANY

A request was received from a representative of R. M. Bradley & Company that two articles for rezoning of two parcels of land be included in the next Special Town Meeting. These articles were submitted over the signature of the owners of the individual parcels. Town Counsel had advised the Board of Selectmen that this type of submission made the format of the article a legal document but that the decision of the Board of Selectmen would determine whether or not it should be included in a special meeting. After a long discussion with a large number of neighbors representing a group called Save Our Neighborhood, the Board voted unanimously that they did not deem this request for rezoning to be an emergency situation and as a result, agreed that the articles would be included in the Annual Town Meeting on a normal basis and should not be included in a Special Town Meeting.

ASSISTANT DOG OFFICER APPOINTMENT

At the request of Selectman Lavin, it was agreed that each of the Selectmen would designate the number of applicants of the seven which were submitted which they wish to have personal interviews with prior to making an appointment as Assistant Dog Officer. It was agreed that each of the Selectmen would advise the Executive Administrator of those people they wish to interview during the December 14 meeting. The interviews would be set up as soon thereafter as possible.
