HEARING RE: MODIFICATION DESCRIPTION OF PREMISES - TIMOTHY'S SPIRITS COMPANY, INC. (Ken's Kasual),
123 GATES STREET

Timothy Hanna appeared on his own behalf requesting that the Board approve a change in the description of premises for the use of the All Alcoholic Restaurant license at this location. He stated that he had purchased a diner which had been completely rehabilitated and located on the exterior of the licensed premises in the area which had been included to allow the serving of alcoholic beverages during good weather at outdoor tables. He asked that the description of premises on the license be modified to include the serving of alcoholic beverages in conjunction with food in the restored diner which is a separate free-standing structure.

Selectman Ernst asked how there could be any assurance that if the diner was sold separately from the balance of the business at any time in the future, there would not be a problem concerning the license covering two separate locations. Mr. Hanna commented that he owned the entire premises and that if the diner was sold it would be sold for removal from the location and the license would not apply to it any longer.

At the end of the discussion, the Board took the matter under advisement.

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INTERVIEW - CONSERVATION ADMINISTRATOR'S APPLICANT

Ms. Sylvia Dennis was accompanied by Robert Venne, a member of the Conservation Commission, to be interviewed by the Board of Selectmen on her application for the position of Conservation Administrator. Ms. Dennis told the Board that she had recently relocated to the New England area from Colorado. In a review of her work experience, it was indicated that she had held many different positions, that each of them had been in the field of conservation in general. During the discussion of her perception of the position and methods of procedure she would adopt, Selectman King asked what procedure she would follow if a major construction project was involved with a Conservation Commission Order of Conditions and there were some questions and problems concerning the requirements for meeting those conditions. Ms. Dennis responded that she would refer the contractor to a consultant.

At the conclusion of the interview, the consensus of opinion of the selectmen was that the specific experience which was presented by Ms Dennis was primarily in an academic field and there was virtually no practical hands-on experience of the type that would be required for the position. It was recommended that other applications be reviewed and if necessary, the position be readvertised seeking further applicants.

SAFETY OFFICER RECOMMENDATION

The Board authorized the recommendation of the Safety Officer to install No Parking Between Signs on Waverly Street at #788 to facilitate the access to property at that location.

POLICE DEPARTMENT APPOINTMENTS

Upon recommendation of Police Chief Larrabee, the Board appointed Acting Lieutenant, Edward Yarosz to the position of permanent full-time Lieutenant and Acting Sergeant, Steven Carl to the position of permanent full-time Sergeant, to be effective February 1, 1988. It was pointed out that all candidates for these positions who were qualified by Civil Service had been previously interviewed by a panel of police officers and the Board of Selectmen so it was felt that further interviews were not required.

CROSSING GUARD RESIGNATION

The Board accepted the resignation of Mary C. Ball from her position as a Crossing Guard effective January 29, 1988. They authorized the Safety Officer to seek a replacement immediately.

RECOMMENDATION FOR ACTING PLANNING DIRECTOR

Upon the recommendation of F. Taintor, the current Planning Director, the Board voted unanimously to appoint Karen S. Margolis as the Acting Planning Director to succeed him until a permanent Planning Director is appointed and begins work.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR FILLING COMMITTEE VACANCIES

Upon the resignation of the current Planning Director, it is necessary to replace him as a member of various committees. Upon his recommendation, the Board appointed Karen Margolis as his replacement on the Major Construction Task Force, the Mapping Committee and the Joint Regional Transportation Committee. In addition, they appointed Louise Masailo as the replacement for the Permanent Building Construction Committee.

FRAMINGHAM LAND TRUST BY-LAWS

Selectman Ernst commented that he had an opportunity to review the proposed Framingham Land Trust By-Laws and he had several questions concerning these by-laws. He suggested that copies of the by-laws be submitted to each of the selectmen and a meeting be held with the Planning Director concerning them prior to their final establishment and acceptance. It was agreed that this procedure would be followed.

The meeting was adjourned at approximately 8:15 P.M.
