HEARINGS - BOSTON EDISON COMPANY PETITIONS

A representative of the Boston Edison Company appeared to petition for approval of installation of conduit  
at three locations on Cochituate Road and one location on Burr Street for the purpose of servicing traffic  
control boxes in conjunction with the rebuilding of Route 30 in that area. Hearing no objections, the Board  
voted 2-0 to approve all four of the petitions. As usual, Selectman King did not participate in the hearings.

CONFERENCE - CABLE TV COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN

Dennis Giombetti appeared on behalf of the Cable TV Committee to present a Boston Red Sox cap to the Chairman  
of the Selectmen to be able to prove that he was not a New York Yankee fan as had been alleged during a  
discussion on the change of channels being provided by the local Cable TV company. On a more serious note,  
Mr. Giombetti commented that the discussion of the selection of cable channels had been very detailed during  
all of the public hearings his committee held and there had been no public objection to the selections made  
as part of the agreement.

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CONFERENCE - ATTORNEY JANICE ROGERS

Attorney Rogers appeared on behalf of Charles and Patricia Hanson to request that the Board assent to a land court action which would clear the title to a strip of land which had been voted for taking for highway purposes many years ago and has been prevented access to the public way from the Hanson Farm. Under arrangements made with the land court, an easement was established if widening or relocation of the road was required at any time in the future. But, it did free the use of the land for the Hanson's. The Board voted unanimously to approve the agreement.

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

The Board voted unanimously to call a Special Town Meeting for the evening of February 24th. Two articles were accepted after the warrant was opened and the warrant was closed limiting the meeting to the two articles in question. One article was for the purpose of modifying the classification and pay plan to reflect changes made under two labor agreements. The second article was inserted to provide funding to meet the requirements of the agreements which had been under labor contracts.

LIQUOR LICENSE APPLICATION

The Board removed the application for an All Alcoholic Beverage license for use in conjunction with a restaurant at the former Jessica's Restaurant on Route 9. The application had been submitted by Timothy Hanna on behalf of Annah Associates, the owners of the premises. The Board reviewed the information presented and the commentary that the Town Counsel provided indicating that there were no legal impediments to the granting of the license. It was voted unanimously that the license should be granted to the location for the restaurant which occupied the lower floor of the building only. It was further voted that no live entertainment should be conducted in conjunction with the restaurant unless specific application for a particular type of entertainment was submitted to the Board for approval prior to the conduct of such entertainment.


METROWEST COMMITTEE FUNDING

Selectman Ernst recommended that a line item be included in the Selectmen's budget for Fiscal Year 1989 in the amount of \$7,000 for the purpose of contributing to the support of the MetroWest Committee. The Board voted unanimously to include this item in the budget.

The Board noted receipt of the following items:

3. Correspondence from Senator Edward Burke re: Cushing Hospital
