BOSTON EDISON COMPANY HEARING

Stephen Kane appeared on behalf of Boston Edison Company on petitions for conduits and manholes for Hemenway Road and Stoneybrook Road. AAs usual, John King did not participate in the hearing. Hearing no opposition, the Board voted 240 to grant the petitions.

CONFERENCE - FRAMINGHAM CELEBRATION COMMITTEE

James Gavin, Chairman of the Celebration Committee introduced Brian Fabbri, Publicity Chairman, and Brian Rowe, Keefe Tech. Faculty, to the Board.

Mr. Gavin reported that Celebration '87 & '88 were both very successful due to the efforts of many individuals. All reporting requirements, both State and Federal have been complied with. Celebration '88 ended \$6,800 in the black, the need is to raise \$10,000 for Celebration Weekend '89. They are planning Raffles, Las Vegas Night, Celebrity Softball, Flea Market, and other events. The Town has been most receptive and seem pleased that Framingham is back on the "Parade Circuit".

Many good things and good will has been generated as a result of these celebrations - the citizens, church groups and schools have developed an interest and a healthy competitiveness with their parade entries. One of the great things that has resulted is the design of the Town of Framingham flag which was the result of the efforts of Mr. Brian Rowe and his students at Keefe Tech. It was part of their award-winning float entry in the '88 parade - "GRAND MARSHALLS' TROPHY - BEST IN PARADE. The flag uses the Town Seal as the main theme and is one that the town should be proud of.

Two members of the committee, both of whom are attorneys, have researched the requirements for the designation of this flag and have determined that no Town Meeting Action is necessary. The Board can accept the flag and designate it as the official flag of the Town of Framingham.

If the Board accepts the flag, the Committee will arrange to have it produced professionally and presented to the town for display in the Peter W. Ablondi Meeting Room. Other uses will develop including incorporating the flag into the design of our '89 T-Shirts and commemorative pins.

The theme for the '89 parade will be EDUCATION: OUR FUTURE, in honor of the 150th Anniversary of Framingham State College.

The Board of Selectmen unanimously accepted the flag design and designated it as the official flag of the Town of Framingham.

CONFERENCE - DENNISON MANUFACTURING COMPANY

Attorney John Garrahan and Nelson Gifford, President of Dennison Manufacturing Company appeared before the Board to outline the company's plan to streamline its operations and to move its corporate headquarters back to Framingham from Waltham. Dennison, at present, employs 1,600 people and that number is not expected to change with the new plan. Other details of the project include: Demolishing half the building space at the complex and transforming the mostly manufacturing and warehouse operations into offices. Closing Clinton Street and part of Howard Street to give a "campus" look to the project and allow for extra parking. Moving workers to sites in Holliston and Milford. The new headquarters will still have about 1,600 employees in Framingham, but more will be white-collar workers than blue-collar workers. Beginning work at the six acre site in 1989 and finishing the entire project by 1992. Transforming the mill buildings into a modern office complex that will not harm the historical facade. The architectural firm hired to design the offices, Sasaki Associates, Inc. of Waltham, said the end result will be much like the Digital Equipment Corporation mill offices in Maynard.

The only opposition to the development centered on the company's request to close two streets. Selectmen said the horrendous traffic jams at Dennison Crossing must be addressed. The closing of the streets could also cause a public safety problem by taking away a short cut for fire trucks and other emergency vehicles. Town Meeting member Barbara Ford, speaking for neighborhood residents, said the company should also buy back Clark's Hill, which was recently sold to the Fafard Company.

Mr. Gifford plans to submit to Town Meeting two articles, one article asking that the town abandon part of Howard Street so that a campus-type environment would be in front of the Dennison building and two, the abandonment of part of Clinton Street. One benefit would be the improvement of the intersection of Howard and Bishop Streets at Beaver Street. The suggested traffic pattern would be to travel up Grant Street to Clark Street - left to Bishop Street and right to Dennison Crossing. Part of Howard Street would be closed and part of Clinton Street would be closed. Selectman DelPrete stated that the narrowness of Grant Street, the Concord Street traffic and the intersection of the streets would have to be addressed. The flow of traffic was one of the problems to be resolved. The members of the Board as well as local legislators and the Chamber of Commerce were unanimously in favor of the proposed project. The Selectmen also voted to have a "Major Construction Task Force" made up of the Executive Administrator, town officials and department heads. Also, the Committee on Planning & Zoning as well as the neighbors were to be kept informed by the representatives of the Dennison project.

CONFERENCE - PERSONNEL DIRECTOR - INSURANCE COST CONTROL

John Harland appeared to give an indepth explanation and review of the Insurance Cost Control savings to the Town. Mr. Harland submitted print-out sheets and figures showing the claims received and how much the company saved the Town in insurance. He stated that without a consultant, that errors in billings would not be picked up, and that the consultants were keeping Blue Cross/Blue Shield competitive with other plans. Selectmen King and DelPrete questioned Mr. Harland at length regarding the Insurance Cost Control Contract. The Selectmen also questioned the amount of compensation paid out on Workmen's Compensation. The Town has paid more than \$3 million in Workmen's Compensation to 422 employees since the town voted in 1981 to be self-insured. Currently, 27 town workers are receiving Workmen's Compensation. This year's budget is for \$650,000. John Harland stated that the town has saved money by being self-insured. The Town pays \$150,000 in insurance to protect against health claims of more than \$60,000. Selectman King stated that Mr. Harland was keeping adequate records but he was not monitoring the claims efficiently.

At the conclusion of the meeting, the Board requested Mr. Harland to return at a future date with facts as to the number of employees who were out sick during 1988 and the resulting cost to the town. An Absenteeism Cost Analysis is to be presented at that time showing the total number of days employees are out of work and the cost to the town of these non-productive days.

RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE SAFETY OFFICER

Upon recommendations of the Safety Officer, the Board voted the installation of the following sign:

NO PARKING - 7 AM - 9 AM and 4 PM - 6 PM, on Concord Street, east side from Mechanic Street to Fuller Street.

Upon the recommendation of the Town Engineer, the Board voted unanimously to have the Callahan State Park Representatives install two crosswalk signs and striping on Edmands Road.
