CONFERENCE: ROSEMARY CASEY RE: MARCH OF DIMES WALK-A-THON:

The Board held a conference with Rosemary Casey of the March of Dimes Walk-A-Thon. She commended the Town for the support she has received in this endeavor.

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CONFERENCE: PRISCILLA CHAFITZ RE: SONS OF MARY PROPERTY:

A conference was held with the citizens from the neighborhood where the Sons of Mary are located. In attendance were Kathy Robertson from the Department of Corrections and Ms. Larson from Sons of Mary along with the numerous neighbors.

A list of questions were presented to the Board. These questions were then addressed and discussed. It was the general feeling of the public that Framingham was doing its part in helping to provide space, facilities and programs for people in need of help. However, in this case the Town and the neighborhood were never informed that a pre-release program had been established at the Sons of Mary.

Mr. Gadbois read a memo from Lt. Teal of the Framingham Police Department which outlined how and when the Town was informed of the program being established at the Sons of Mary. Another memo read by Mr. Gadbois was to Chairman of the Selectmen, John King, by Richard McIntosh, Building Commissioner. This document outlined "The use of the facility at #567 Salem End Road - formally "Sons of Mary".

Selectman John King spoke at length on the topic and felt strongly that the State was irresponsible in handling this matter. There were poor communications at best and there was a question about the legality of the program in regards to the use of the program in that Zoning district. Mr. Gadbois was requested to seek the advice of the Town Counsel.

CONSTABLE APPOINTMENT:

The request of Mr. Theodore Milgroom to be re-appointed as a Constable was approved by the Board. The appointment is for three years.

CONFERENCE - PHIL DICASOLO OF Y.M.C.A. RE: CIRCUS PERMIT:

The Board, after having their concerns addressed concerning safety factors approved the request for a Circus permit.


DOWNTOWN CROSSING:
