CONFERENCE - STEPHEN POLECHRONIS RE: COMMUTER RAIL EXTENSION FEASIBILITY STUDY:

A conference was held with Stephen Polechronis of the M.B.T.A. regarding the extension of commuter rail to area North, South and West of Framingham. The commuter rail extensions were outlined on a large map and showed routes to Worcester, Milford, Marlboro and areas on Route 495. Also, the concept of leasing the Parking Garage was raised by Selectman John King. The conference concluded with Stephen Polechronis stating he would be working closely with the Town on the progress of the project.

REQUEST FROM PURCHASING AGENT RE: WAIVER OF PURCHASING BY-LAW:

The Board voted unanimously to grant a waiver of the Purchasing By-Law in order to make immediate repairs to the Incinerator Building.

SAFETY OFFICER RECOMMENDATION:
