

HISTORIC DISTRICT COMMISSION

MEETING: April 28, 1982

Meeting called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Galvani.

1. Chairman Galvani reported that Executive Administrator Clarke has allocated \$50. to the commission for stationery, postage, etc. Stationery has been printed.
2. Chairman Galvani distributed copies of a letter sent to Building Inspector Seeley, indicating the jurisdiction of this commission over the Center Common Historic District and requesting that applicants for changes in properties of the district be informed of appropriate procedures.
3. Chairman Galvani indicated that he will request the Board of Selectmen to designate members of this commission as special municipal employees as is done with other town commissions and boards.
4. There was a discussion of a filing fee in order to offset administrative expenses of the commission.

MOTION: (Sullivan, Warren) to set the filing fee at \$20.00. Unanimous approval.

5. Chairman Galvani introduced Richard Shea of the Metropolitan Area Planning Council, and co-author of "Preserving Framingham's History."

Mr. Shea discussed the role of his organization in providing technical assistance to communities in planning and in helping them to place properties on the National Register of Historic Places.
