New Business: Ch. Evans has completed the National Register application for the Chapel in Edgell Grove Cemetery. She passed around photos that will accompany the application. With regard to the information the Mass. Historical Commission wants on any additional sites to be considered for the National Register Ch. Evans would like them to suggest a procedure.

These letters suggest procedure to insure the protection of Historic properties with respect to the town's Housing Rehabilitation Assistance program.

Regarding correspondence from Mr. Foxcroft about Mr. Fafard's historic Barn being remodelled into a Coach House. Ch. Evans answered his letter feeling permission for photos should come from Mr. Fafard.
