

The meeting of the Framingham Historical Commission was held on Wednesday, June 15, 1988 at 7:30 pm in Lower Nevins Hall, Framingham. Present and presiding Molly Evans, Jerry Silverberg, and Bonnie Bryant. The minutes of the last meeting were read by Molly Evans and accepted as read.

There has been no further word from Mr. Greco of the Old Colony Hotel regarding his application for National Historic Register.

Molly Evans gave a report on the Preservation Conference she attended in New Bedford, MA, on May 13, 1988. The conference was sponsored by Historic Massachusetts, Inc. and Massachusetts Historical Commission.

Molly Evans attended an open house at the former Caleb Bridges House. At present the entry from the parking lot is into the basement where the fitness equipment is located. Upstairs there are small social rooms with the main room open for the two stories.

Edgell Chapel will be open on September 18 in connection with the 100th anniversary celebration of the Framingham Historical Society. Molly Evans will contact the Trustees of the cemetery regarding the status of the application for National Historic Register.

Bonnie Bryant will determine the current responsibility for the old cemeteries in town.

The meeting was adjourned until a date to be determined in September.
