**HISTORICAL COMMISSION**

January 17, 1991

The meeting of the Framingham Historical Commission was called to order by Chairperson Molly Evans at 7:30 PM in the Memorial Building.

Present: Chairperson Evans, Heli Meltsner, Steve Herring and Jerry Silverberg

The Secretary's minutes were read, modified and approved.

Heli called the developers of the property containing the GATES HOUSE. They are looking for a variance on widening Country Club Lane. They want to move the house to another site on the same property but have a problem concerning wetlands. They intend to file a request with the Conservation Commission to build close to the wetlands.

Heli reported that she and member J. Silverberg modified the DEMOLITION BY-LAW, based upon input from the Town Counsel, prior to submission for the Town Warrant. There was still time for further modifications so copies of the modified By-law were circulated and discussed. Several modifications were made and accepted.

Major discussion on Section 3.5. Two separate versions were developed; one with a newspaper notice and one with public notice in the Town Hall. Heli will review this with Town Counsel and change the By-law prior to final submission for the Warrant.

Chairperson Molly Evans submitted her resignation which was at first refused and then accepted. A vote for a new Chair will be held at the next meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
